Sri M. Krishna Murthy, Secretary



Student Feedback:

On Faculty performance

A formal student feedback system regarding faculty performance is in vague for the last five year.

Under this system, Feedback in a structured form is obtained from all the students twice in a year to evaluate teaching-learning process in respect of the subjects taught by each faculty.

Each parameter is quantified and rated on a 4-point rating scale. After compilation, the summary of the feedback showing their rating against each parameter and the overall rating against the 'set threshold level' is communicated to the respective faculty to strive for improvement in the parameter rated below threshold level.

The Osmania University (our affiliating University) also collects feedback from the students on academic performance such as, conducting classes as per timetable, quality of teaching, completion of syllabus on time by a teacher, library facilities etc., and communicate the observations.
